

### How can I get started if my company already uses Valispace and Altium 365?

### If a user makes requirements/comments in Altium 365, are these visible in Altium Designer?

Yes! All design data including comments, requirements, and verification status is accessible from Altium Designer or the Altium 365 Web Viewer. We are currently investigating which parameters and features to integrate next. Currently, our focus includes part change notifications (PCNs) and a proactive alert.

### Is it possible to assign the same requirement to multiple parts of the design?

You can assign requirements in the schematic and layout in the same way as Comments.

Comment for Area (Ctrl+Alt+A) - Allows you to make a comment that relates to a defined rectangular area on the active document.

Comment for Point (Ctrl+Alt+P) - Allows you to make a comment related to a particular point on the active document.

Comment for Object (Ctrl+Alt+C) - Allows you to make a comment that relates to a single selected component on the active document.

### As a project manager, how do I quickly see the progress of requirements linking? How can I tell whether ALL my circuit is covered by at least one requirement?

Automated traceability is very important for Requirements Manager. Dynamic requirement visibility and reuse allows you to see all placed requirements in the context of your design data to quickly know the Who, What, Where, When, and Why for every requirement.
